AL FRANKLIN SNELL WAS BORN IN STAMPING GROUND KENTUCKY ON JUNE 28, 1942 TO THE UNION OF THE LATE BENJAMIN FRANKLIN SNELL & MAGGIE CARTER SNELL.

HE WAS A FORMER MEMBER OF WATKINSVILLE BAPTIST CHURCH OF STAMPING GROUND KENTUCKY. HE LATER JOINED NEW HOPE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF LEXINGTON, KENTUCKY, WHERE HE SERVED AS A TRUSTEE AND USHER UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF THE REV. BOBBIE LONG. HE WAS ALSO RETIRED FROM THE KING RANCH FARMS AFTER 30 YEARS.
