Arizona Blake White, 96, died peacefully on Monday, February 28, 2022. She was born in Lexington, Kentucky, on November 18, 1925, to the late Arthur Felix and Emma Belle Blake.

She was a member of Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church where she worked faithfully for many years. She was an assistant church clerk, a Sunday School teacher, a choir member, a member of The 1951 Club and of The Culinary Committee.
