She was a member of Pilgrim Baptist Church. Mrs. Gill was active in many, many events in Lexington. She worked tirelessly in all she was involved with. In addition to the public school system, Mrs. Gill lent time and support to the Lexington Youth Symphony Orchestra as well as the Lexington Christian Women's Club.

She sang in the church choir for many years and in earlier years of the church, she was in charge of the BTU workshop, served as president of the Deacon's Wives Auxiliary and was an active member in both the 1962 Club and the Progressive Club. In later years, she went on chair the Baptism Ministry. At the District and State level, Mrs. Gill served as secretary numerous times for the Howard's Creek Convention, chaired the local institute of the Lexington and Vicinity Baptist Women's Educational Convention, served as treasurer of the BWE Convention and was a lifetime member of the Missionary Society.

Mrs. Gill was the widow of Mr. James Gill, Sr., and this union was blessed with four sons, including Freddie Gill of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, who also preceded her in death. Remaining to cherish her memory and continue her legacy are her three surviving sons, Greg Gill, Tony Gill and James Gill, Jr., all of Lexington; eleven grandchildren and eleven great-
