Deloris Maxcine Maupin was born in Madison County, Kentucky on August 28, 1941, to the late Pattie Farris and Isaac Maupin, Sr. She passed from this life in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on Saturday, May 8, 2021, at the age of 79.

Maxcine, as she was called, spent her childhood through early adulthood in Lexington, Kentucky, where she attended the original Dunbar High School and did clerical work for the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

She received Christ at an early age at Farristown Baptist Church and attended Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church in Lexington. In Milwaukee, Maxcine worked for the U.S. Department of Defense as a secretary at the Billing Transportation System. She also prepared individual income tax returns and worked as a teacher's assistant for the Milwaukee Public Schools.

Maxcine enjoyed working with her hands. She will be remembered breaking down and re-posturing used furniture, as well as knitting and crocheting items for family and friends. Maxcine also loved to cook. She enjoyed cooking so much that she would prepare enough food to pass out plates to those who lived around her. One of her neighbors, who was unaware of her passing, said that he knew something was wrong when he did not smell all the wonderful aromas typically coming from her apartment.

Maxcine was a loving caretaker for several of her siblings. She took her younger sister, Audrey Ann, and raised her as her own. Then she assisted Audrey in the raising of her children, DeMonica and Clarence. For a short time, she also cared for her older brother Ike. In addition to her parents, Maxcine was preceded in death by a sister, Mary E. Maupin Jackson, and five brothers, Leroy Maupin (infant), William Kenneth Maupin, Isaac "Ike" Maupin, Jr., Charles Leon Maupin and Anthony "Blood" Taylor.
