Iva Dean Robertson was born in Adair County, Kentucky on February 1, 1944, to the late Stanley and Adell McWhorter Robertson. The Lord called her home on Saturday, October 19, 2024.

Iva Dean caused laughter wherever she was. When hospitalized, she would have her visitors, nurses and doctors laughing. Dean was always 'willfully' giving to family, friends, even neighbors, putting her needs on hold so others would have what they needed.
