Luke Edward Fain, 69, of Lexington, KY, husband of Naomi Fain, was called home to be with the Lord on January 13, 2024. He was born to the late John H. Fain & Mary A. Fain on August 20, 1954, in Lexington, KY, one of eleven children. He gave his life to the Lord as a child, being baptized at the House of God. Luke joined Now Faith Worship Center in 1994, faithfully serving as Treasurer and ordained as a Deacon, under the leadership of Rev. Arlester Washington, in 2015. He also used his gift of singing as a faithful member of The Anointed Central Kentucky Mass Choir. Luke always proved himself to be dedicated & hardworking, even as a youth. Following their father's musical talent, Luke and his brothers shared a love for music, which led them to form a family band, formerly known as the "Faintastics". A graduate of Bryan Station High School, he joined the US Airforce in 1975, serving in the capacity of Security Police, & joined the US Navy in 1978 aboard the USS Dominant. After serving in the military, he established careers as a licensed Electrician and a Postman, retiring from the US Postal Service and University of Kentucky Transportation.

In addition to his parents, Luke was preceded in death by three brothers, Mark Fain, John Fain, Jr., and Carl Roberts, and son Kelly Robinson.
