



Dr. Nathan Richard Sullivan

August 10, 1944 - May 6, 2022

Dr. Nathan Richard Sullivan was born on August 10, 1944 in Sturgis (Union County) Kentucky. He was the 7th of 13 children born to the late Grace Richards-Sullivan and Eld. Fred F. Sullivan, Sr. He confessed a hope in Christ at a young age, and was called to his eternal rest on Friday May 06, 2022.

After high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force--completing basic training, Medical Specialist training, and an assignment to the Air Force Hospital in Weisbaden, Germany where he worked on the VIP ward 3E team which was assigned to care for President Kennedy during his visit to Germany. After four years in the military, Doctor Sullivan was honorably discharged in 1966.

His educational pursuits led him to the Univ. of Kentucky where he received his Masters Degree in Social Work and where he met and married his wife of 54 years, Irma J. Waye. To this union two daughters were born. During his career, he served on and chaired numerous Boards and Committees. He successfully completed the course-work and qualifying exams for the Doctorate in Education Policy Studies while working full time at various agencies, including Comp Care, ESH, Substance Abuse, etc.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Fred and Grace Sullivan; his daughter, Tonya M. Sullivan, 3 brothers: Freddie Sullivan, Jr., Cecil Sullivan Sr., and David B. Sullivan; 3 sisters: Hazel Lattimer, Elois Price, and Esther Allen.

He leaves to cherish his memory, his wife, Irma Sullivan, one daughter, Tera J.
