August 27, 1932 - January 20, 2024

On Saturday morning, January 20, 2024, the Lord extended His hand to our beloved and took her home to rest.

Roberta Spillman Yates, daughter of the late Ida Glass Rogers and Robert Spillman, was born in Jessamine County, Kentucky, August 27, 1932. She was preceded in death by a sister, Elizabeth

Spillman Smith and brothers Leslie Spillman, Lonnie Spillman, and Marshall Walker.

On November 21, 1951 she was united in holy matrimony to Percy Lee Yates. To this union was

born one daughter, Shelia, and one son Percy Jr., who preceded her in death. Her beloved

Sunday School, worship services, and weekly Bible study. She was later appointed to the position as a Church Mother—a labor she sweetly embraced.
