Stella Virginia Hayes, 89, Died on January 29, 2017 at Providence Pine Meadows Nursing Facility.

Born December 14, 1927 in Danville, Illinois, Mrs. Hayes was the youngest of two daughters born to James Alvin Harmon and Nell Napier Harmon. The family moved to Lexington when Mrs. Hayes was a young child. She was educated in the Lexington school system and graduated from the old Paul Lawrence Dunbar High School. Mrs. Hayes worked at several Lexington hospitals between 1960 and 1970. In 1970, Mrs. Hayes and her two sons accompanied her husband to Germany while he was working on a special assignment for the United States government. After returning from Germany, Mrs. Hayes was employed with GTE from 1975 to 1990.

Mrs. Hayes was preceded in death by her parents, an older sister, Marilyn Harmon Greene and a son, Robert Alvin (Spike) Wilson.
